Israel for Congress High School Internship Program

Congressman Steve Israel was first elected to Congress in 2000. Following the 2010 census and redistricting, Congressman Israel was elected to represent the newly drawn 3rd Congressional District on the North Shore of Long Island.

Congressman Israel's 2014 campaign is looking for motivated high school students to add to the team of dedicated interns. The internship will start in early September and last until Election Day – November 4, 2014.

Job Description:

Interns will perform a variety of tasks throughout the campaign. The following is a list of the most frequently required tasks:

- Assist Field Organizer in daily activities.
- Execute the field plan created by the Field Director.
- Conduct voter outreach following specific data driven voter targeting to maximize turnout on Election Day.
- Recruit and train new volunteers for voter outreach.
- Use the Voter Activation Network (VAN) database to enter and track voter data.
- Participate in GOTV the weekend before the election.

If there is anything not listed above that you are interested in or if you have any questions about the previously listed tasks do not hesitate to discuss it with your field organizer.

Expectations:

- All interns are expected to work 10-15 hours per week.
- All interns are expected to be available for the weekend before the election.
- Be on time to all of your shifts. If you will be late, or cannot make a shift, notify your assigned Field Organizer.
- Conduct yourself in a professional manner. The office dress code is business casual.

Driving is not required but the campaign cannot provide transportation to or from the office. Having a laptop is preferred, but not necessary, as some tasks will require a computer.
