
Performing Arts Crew Internship – Great Neck South High School 2014-2015

Internship Job Descriptions

General Note: Internships include work on The Theatre South and the Music Department Shows, plus other student or staff-sponsored events such as Martin Luther King Day, the Fashion Show.

Attitude and effort count.....you do not receive credit if you are sitting in the corner texting.

Lighting: Up to 3 individuals

General responsibilities:

Work crew calls to hang/focus lights.
Work tech rehearsals for musical, play, opera, one-acts, concerts, etc.
Work strikes/changeovers after show closes.
Some shows may need a backstage electrician.

Specifically:

- Run Lighting Board or Follow Spot for at least 5 events HOWEVER the musical may be counted as 2 events as the tech period is longer. Naturally you are always welcome to work on more than this!
- Put in at least 20 hours at scheduled crew calls during the school year. These are usually after school, but occasionally on weekends.

Sound: Up to 3 individuals

General responsibilities:

Work crew calls to set up mics, monitors, speakers, etc.
Work tech rehearsals for musical, play, opera, one-acts, concerts, etc.
Work strikes/changeovers after show closes.
Some shows may need a backstage sound technician.

Specifically:

- Run or assist at Sound Board for at least 5 events HOWEVER the musical may be counted as 2 events as the tech period is longer. Naturally you are always welcome to work on more than this!
- Put in at least 20 hours at scheduled crew calls during the school year. These are usually after school, but occasionally on weekends.

Stage Crew: Up to 8 individuals

General responsibilities:

Work crew calls to build or paint set or props.
Work tech rehearsals for musical, play, opera, one-acts, concerts, etc.
Work strikes/changeovers after show closes.
Work running crew during show.
Attend meetings called by crew chief.

Specifically:

- Be on running crew for at least 5 events HOWEVER the musical may be counted as 2 events as the tech period is longer. Naturally you are always welcome to work on more than this!
- Put in at least 20 additional hours at scheduled crew calls (does not include running crew) during the school year. These are usually after school, but occasionally on weekends.

Internship Job Descriptions

Costumes/Make-up: Up to 4 individuals.

General responsibilities:

Work calls to pull or construct costumes, fittings as needed,.

Work tech rehearsals for musical, play, opera, one-acts, concerts, etc.

Work cleanups after show closes.

Work makeup or wardrobe for productions.

Specifically:

- Run wardrobe or makeup for at least 3 events HOWEVER the musical may be counted as 2 events as the tech period is longer. Naturally you are always welcome to work on more than this!
- Put in at least 20 hours at scheduled costume calls during the school year.
